



CALL FOR APPLICATION to the

INTERNATIONAL SUMMER SCHOOL “GINO GORLA”
Introduction to the American Legal System and Legal writing in English
2nd Edition - 2019

Art. 1 - Object and scope.

The Association of Graduate Students in Law of University of Rome Tor Vergata, hereinafter “**Juristor**”, in accordance with the University of Rome Tor Vergata, within its policy to promote the international exchange of students and postgraduates, is selecting the participants for the 2019 edition of the Summer School – 2nd Edition.

The program is dedicated to “Gino Gorla”, professor of Comparative Law in Rome who was involved in the “Cornell Seminars” organized by Rudolf Schlesinger in 1964 and was one of the pioneers of comparative law between Italy and the United States.

The program is under the direction of professors Massimo Papa and Bruno Sassani and lectures will be held by professors from Syracuse University – College of Law, on the basis of mutual agreements with Tor Vergata University and with Juristor.

The aim of the Summer School is to provide students with the opportunity to understand the peculiar view of Law typical of Common Law countries directly from professionals who are involved in the legal practice in the United States of America and have a real experience of teaching to foreign students. Moreover, in the era of globalization, the acquisition of basics of legal writing skills in English can be a fruitful experience for those who may be willing to work in the corporate consulting or who actually work for international law firms. The initiative is extended also to the undergraduate students who may be willing to join the course for educational purposes.

Duration : 2 weeks Monday to Friday from July 15 to July 26 (5 working days per week);

Times: Morning 10 – 13; Afternoon 14.30 - 17.30



Art. - 2 Requirements.

The applicants to the Summer School should meet the following requirements:

- to be alternatively
 - graduated from a University in Italy or any other European university;
 - an undergraduate student of the University of Rome Tor Vergata;
- to have a sufficient knowledge of English alternatively
 - certified from an official institute of language and equivalent to the level B2 on the [Cambridge English Language Assessment](#);
 - to pass an oral exam held by Juristor.

The date of the oral exam of english language will be published on our website www.juristor.it and applicants are required to check the date and participate in order to be admitted to the school. The impossibility to participate to the oral exam does not enable applicants to be refunded for the fees.

Article 3 – Fees and Scholarships

The cost of the program for a single participant is different depending on the status of partner of our association and will cover all costs of the material and the course for the entire duration:

| Category | Fees (including taxes) |

| Junior Partners of Juristor: undergraduate students in law at Tor Vergata that have already awarded 100 Credits (CFU) during their academic course | € 400,00 |
| Senior Partners of Juristor: Applicants graduated in law at Tor Vergata | € 450,00 |
| Others | € 610,00 |

People other than partners that are eligible to become partners according to the Bylaws of Juristor can submit the request with their application and pay the fees



reserved to partners. Application for partnership implies no other cost than that specified above and the annual 20 euro are included in the fees for the summer school.

The Association may grant 5 scholarships, covering all fees or part of them, to the students with outstanding CV, also considering any financial difficulties certified by an ISEE declaration.

Applicants that do not have a sufficient knowledge of English certified from an official institute of language for at least level B2 on the Cambridge English Language Assessment cannot apply for scholarships.

- ISEE declaration;

The request of scholarship shall be evaluated and the decision communicated to the applicant by e-mail, with the indication of time and amount of the payment required in case of partial scholarship.

Applicants granted with scholarships are invited to be present to all the courses of the Summer School or at least to 75% of total hours of class, otherwise the scholarship will be waived and the fees required entirely.

Art. 4 – Certificate of attendance

At the end of the course all participants who attend at least 75% of the program will receive a certificate of attendance of the course.
